Speaker: Ian Thomas from the Rotary Club of Eltham spoke to us about Aquabox, which is a major Rotary initiative providing aid both here & overseas to communities in crisis. Of all the international aid programs Rotary programs such as Aquabox are among the most highly respected for the reason that Rotarians provide careful management of the arrival & appropriate circulation of goods. In the case of Aquabox, goods are packed in a rented workshop in Eltham by Rotarians & once in shipping containers are monitored on arrival by local Rotarians who ensure that the aid gets to where it is meant to go, not siphoned off in other directions. Aquabox Gold costs \$480 to produce & Aquabox 30 \$750. All goods are new—some specially manufactured in Australia for Aquabox. The water filtration system in the larger box provides enough water for a family of 4 for 4-6 months. Other items in the larger box include cotton blankets, folding shovel, mosquito nets, a tarp, anchor rope, pliers, torch, camp set for food, a fold up fry pan, soap, string & wire. Recently 108 boxes have been sent to a group of remote villages in Pakistan.
