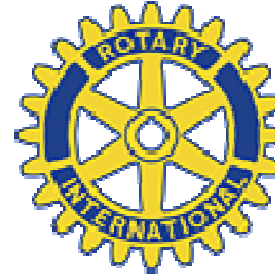

Speaker: Frances Acquah said that Mental Health First Aid was the brain-child of two Canberra mental health professionals, Tony Jorm & Betty Kitchener. By 2005, when it had become fully operational, it was taken up by Orygen, an adolescent mental health program at the University of Melbourne. In recent years several versions have been established. And the program has been taken up by mental health professionals in Britain, Vietnam, China & the USA. It is a twelve hour programme usually run over several days & covers depression, anxiety, psychosis & substance abuse. Francis ended his presentation with an excellent video, demonstrating the ALGEE approach—Assess, Listen non-judgementally, Give support & information, Encourage the sufferer to find professional help & Encourage the sufferer to communicate with supportive friends & family.
