BOARD MEETING

The Board accepted with regret Bob McCulloch’s decision to step down from the Board and thanked him for his work. A meeting with Simon Bowden re Trivia Night will be organized shortly. Simon will prepare a flyer, has questions in hand and has prepared a letter of invitation and letters to request auction items from local traders. Katy will be Trivia Night bookings officer. Agreed we will do a ‘dry run’ of setting up 12 tables to see what is manageable. Agreed that EPIC should receive \$300 (as planned in the budget). Frances will see if Olympic Preschool would be a suitable recipient of a plaque from our club, and Keith will be asked similarly about Olympic Adult Education, given our club’s long-standing support for these two community organisations. Graham says \$3126 is in the bank, with another \$7000 on deposit. Yearly membership fees of \$280 are now due (or \$150 twice annually). Every Rotarian Every Year payment will be organized by Katy & Graham.

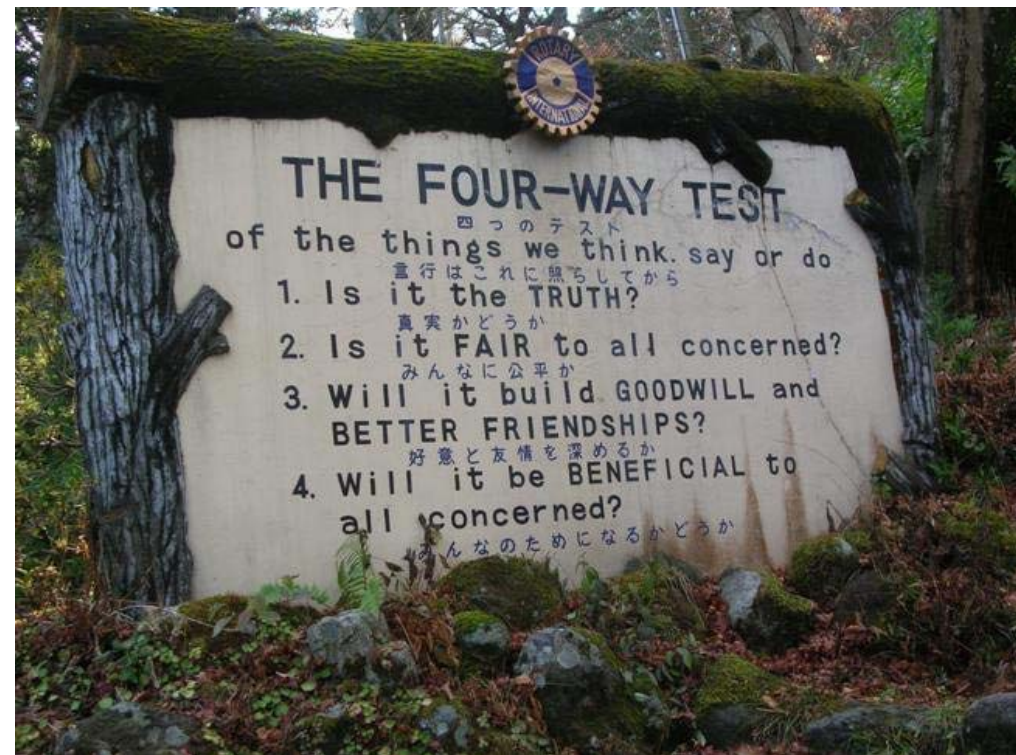
