Speaker: Said Aden told us about the trials of his early life as a doctor in Somalia, where he was unable to provide proper medical care because of lack of facilities and where his patients were suffering from severe malnutrition. In 1990 he was faced with the civil war, and to his great distress the rebel soldiers destroyed the whole hospital. He fled with his family to Kenya & from there he came to Australia. In 1998 he completed a Master of Public Health at Monash. Following various positions in public health in Victoria he has taken UNICEF positions in Kenya & Sudan & will shortly fly to Liberia on an HIV/AIDS program. In Melbourne he has set up a FOAD office at a Neighbourhood House at 155 Oriel Rd West Heidelberg, where volunteers will raise funds for a school toilets rebuilding project in Kibera in Nairobi & will arrange for the sale of Somali craft products in Melbourne.
